son will be doing Sailing 101 for newcomers.

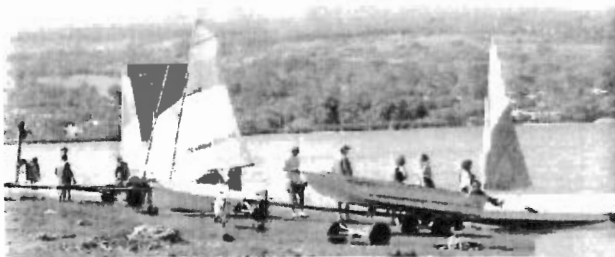
You are invited to participate in the club **workday** on Saturday the 27th at 10AM.
